HAWAII PROPOSED MEDICAL MARIJUANA BILL ~ HB 923

Title: Relating to Health (HI HB 923)

Date Introduced: January 26, 2011

Description: Creates three classes of medical marijuana licenses: class 1 medical marijuana compassion center license for the sale of medical marijuana to qualified patients; class 2 medical marijuana cultivation license; class 3 medical marijuana-infused products manufacturing license. Specifies requirements for each class. Makes medical marijuana sales subject to income and excise taxes. Establishes a special marijuana sales tax on sales of medical marijuana. Establishes a fee for issuance and renewal of a license and a special marijuana sales tax.

Sponsor(s): Ito

What the bill will do:

- 1. There will be a 15% sales tax on all sales of medical marijuana, the proceeds of which will be deposited into the general fund.
- 2. Qualifying patients may only designate one compassion center as their supplier of medical marijuana.

ASA's recommended action: ASA opposes taxing medical cannabis.
